

## COVID-19 Safety Plan for Re-opening LBC

The Committee of the Launceston Bridge Club will do our best to provide a safe environment for our members to return to face to face bridge in accordance with Tasmanian Government regulations.

However, EVERY MEMBER is obliged to follow the rules set out below and do their part in keeping the membership safe.

**1. IF YOU ARE UNWELL, STAY AT HOME, If you have a temperature or any symptoms of cold or flu you will be asked to leave.**

**2. Everyone will have their temperature taken with a non contact thermometer, as they enter the premises.**

**3. Everyone will be asked to use the hand sanitiser provided at the door, and collect a pen which you must keep with you for the duration of play.**

**4. All members will be admitted by the BACK (KITCHEN) DOOR. The front door will be locked to outside access. Members may leave by either door at the end of the session.**

**5. After being “checked in” at the back door, you are requested to go directly to a seat and stay there. Your belongings will be stowed under the table beside you. This is to stop people congregating at the back of the room. Please observe the “distancing” rules at all times.**

**6. There will be NO tea breaks or refreshments available, the kitchen will be closed, but you may bring a labelled water bottle/refreshment for your personal use.**

**7. We will have a Cashless Voucher System in place early in July. Until then you are requested to BRING THE EXACT TABLE MONEY OF A \$5 NOTE. COINS WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED.**

**8. The size of our premises means that we can only accommodate 9 tables under the 4 square meter rule. Therefore, YOU WILL HAVE TO PRE-REGISTER for every session. Refer to the list of “Registrars” below.**

**When a session is full, you will be put on the list for the following week. You cannot say you wish to play every Friday.**

**9. Hand Sanitiser will be provided for each person at your table, and must be used prior to play at each new table after the move is called. There will be wipes at every table, and you are requested to wipe down your part of the table before starting the new round.**

**10. At the end of a session the director will designate one person from each table to empty the rubbish bins (NSEW) remembering to maintain distancing. A new large bin will be placed near the front door for this purpose.**

**11. The director will announce the winners from the stage in order to stop members congregating around the results board.**

**12. We encourage every member to install the government's contact tracing app. This will enable speedy contact tracing if any of our members is unlucky enough to contract the virus and then visit our club. Should there be an incident of Covid19 at the club we will immediately cease operations.**

**13. List of Registrars for each session. Please keep this list handy.**

**If you don't register you can't play.**

**All sessions except Wednesday Supervised, please register as a pair.**
